

KanCare Eligibility and Enrollment



Are You Covered?



- KanCare offers coverage for children, pregnant women, families with children, elderly, adults with disabilities and children with disabilities.
- The economic effects of COVID-19 could make more Kansans eligible for Medicaid insurance.

KanCare Medicaid Plan Enrollment

- If you think you might be eligible for services, you can apply for KanCare with the State of Kansas. To apply for KanCare services and enroll in a health plan:
 - Call the KanCare Enrollment Center at 1-800-792-4884 (TTY: 1-800-766-3777).
 - Or visit the KanCare website, www.kancare.ks.gov/.



KanCare Medicaid Plan Enrollment

- If you or your child is determined to be eligible, you can choose which company will manage your KanCare benefits
- Choosing a health plan company (Managed Care Organization or MCO)
 - Each MCO covers the same benefits, but **Value-Added Benefits** (Extra Services) are different for each company
 - Members can select an MCO upon enrollment
 - Members can change their MCO annually without reason or mid-year “for good reason”

Extra Services

Extra Services



- Value Added Benefit – a service we cover or provide that is in addition to Medicaid benefits
- Also referred to as “Extra Services” or “Value Added Services”

Extra Services



Dental Benefits

- Two dental visits (cleanings, screenings) for adults 21 years and older every year
- Children are covered for most dental services under regular Medicaid benefits
- Dentures may be covered for Frail and Elderly and Physical Disability Waiver members

Extra Services: *my*healthpays[®]



Members earn My Health Pays[®] rewards when they complete healthy activities like yearly wellness exams and annual screenings. They can use My Health Pays[®] rewards to help pay for:

- Rent
- Public Transportation
- Telecommunications
- Childcare Services
- Education
- Utilities
- Everyday items at Walmart*
Excluding alcohol, tobacco or firearm products.

Healthy activities eligible for rewards include (not full list):

- **\$10** for completing a Health Risk Screening (One per calendar year)
- **\$50** Annual comprehensive diabetes care. HbA1c test, kidney screening, dilated eye exam. If 2 HbA1c tests are completed in calendar year, then total \$70 max.
- **\$10** per infant well care visit up to 15 months old. (\$60 max.)
- **\$10** annual well care visit with child's primary care doctor. Ages 2-20.
- **\$50** Notification of Pregnancy form. Completed within first trimester. (\$25 if completed within second trimester)
- **\$10** postpartum doctor visit, 4-6 weeks after delivery.

Extra Services



Free Smartphone through *SafeLink*®

- These come with free limited data and voice minutes per month, unlimited texting and free calls to and from Sunflower. Members can sign up online.

Home Visiting

- Community-based health services staff can provide in-home member visits to assist with scheduling healthcare appointments and transportation.
- Assist members with accessing food, shelter or other health or social programs. This service is complementary to case management and is performed by certified Community Health Workers.

Extra Services: *Start Smart* for Your Baby®



Program for pregnant members, babies and families

Nursing support, education and gifts

WIC transportation

- Limited to 4 round trips (8 one-way trips per calendar year)
- Rides provided via ModivCare

No cost services:

- In-home help with benefits and community services
- Special texting program for Start Smart participants
- Community baby showers for pregnant members, with diapers and other items
- Birthday programs for children

- Boys & Girls Club
- Sunflower Adopt-A-Schools

Sunny's Kids Club

- Educational activity book sent upon sign up
- Fun kids' health books mailed quarterly
- Sign up online

Farmers Market Vouchers

- \$10 in coupon vouchers for members at special "Member Day" farmers market events around Kansas



Extra Services



In-home Telehealth

- Available for adults with diabetes and heart failure
- This service helps members stay at home when they need help to manage their chronic conditions.

- Weight management
- Disease management program
- Chronic health conditions
- Managing emotions

Extra Services



MyStrength – Digital Mental Health

- Offers eLearning to help members overcome depression and anxiety.
- Sign up is free on Sunflower website.

Nursing Home to Community Transition Support

- Pre-placement meetings
- Follow up visits
- One week of home delivered meals

Caregiving Collaborations[®]

- Includes the Caregiver Resource Center and a Caregiver Journal
- Each member and caregiver will continue to receive coordination of respite

Extra Services



Employment Support & Transportation (STEP)

- Removes employment barriers
- Enhanced transportation services, GED Ready and GED test vouchers, counseling and STEP scholarship information.



Extra Services for Frail & Elderly (F/E) & Physical Disability (PD) Waiver Members



Extra Services for Frail & Elderly (F/E) & Physical Disability (PD) Waiver Members



- Dentures are covered for members receiving F/E and PD waiver benefits. Eligibility is based on determination of need.
- Meals home delivered to discharged members. (One week, 14 meals.) *KanCare covers this service for PD and Brain Injury (BI) waiver members.*
- Respite Care - up to 24 hours per year for non-paid caregivers.
- Transportation to community events and social activities. (Three round trips per year.)
- Home modification & assistive services to enable individuals to remain living at home. Limits may exceed the \$7500 lifetime waiver limit, but doesn't require crisis criteria and is based on necessity.
- Peer support program. Quarterly calls beginning in March. One-on-one support available through Member Advocate.
- **Added IDD in 2021:** Hospital companionship - up to 16 hours per year.

What Changed?



- Removed Internet service for telemonitoring services & health coaching.
- Added IDD waiver members to hospital companionship benefit.
